Storyline® I: An Introduction is a graduate level course offered through Portland State University for K-12 teachers who wish to learn how to integrate common core curriculum standards through the Storyline method. Mirroring a classroom setting, participants experience a Storyline unit both as a student in the process as well as observer of the teaching method. Teachers will learn how to incorporate meaningful skill development in reading, writing and math as well as integrate social studies, science, technology and health. Explore how and why the Storyline method motivates students to learn as they become their own "meaning makers."
